SEASONAL WORK SCHEME SCAMS

Given the notable increase in the number of reported seasonal work scheme scams, the General Public is hereby advised to be on alert for individuals posing as Officials and/or Approved Employer representatives and taking advantage of unsuspecting individuals eager to find work on seasonal employment schemes.

Registrations for Seasonal Work Schemes

- i. All registrations for work in Australia (PALM scheme) or New Zealand (RSE scheme) ***are free of charge.***
- ii. ***Registrations are on hold for the interim until further notice,*** subject to completion of the recruitment of District Council Staff.
- iii. The Labour Employment Export Program (LEEP) staff are currently assessing all registrations already confirmed on the In-Country Recruitment Database.

Labour Employment Export Program (LEEP)

- i. Only the Labour & Employment Export Program (LEEP), under the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Labour, is authorised to officially manage and administer the RSE and PALM Schemes in Samoa.
- ii. Official communication about participation is ONLY sent via verified official channels, with all operations centralised at the LEEP Office.
