ADVISORY ON FRAUDULENT GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS

The Ministry wishes to inform the general public that it has recently come to our attention that fraudulent and falsified documents are currently being circulated online via Facebook under the pages of 'Benita fx trading' and 'Benita Global' for a company called Bitwise FX Company, falsely claiming to be issued and/or endorsed by our Office.

These fake documents included:

- Certificate of Registration of Business Name, and
- Foreign Investment Certificate.

The Ministry would like to make it absolutely clear that these documents are **not authentic**, they were **not issued** by our Office, and any reliance on such documents is done at your own risk.

Members of the public are strongly urged to exercise caution and to contact our office through our official communication channels to verify the authenticity of any documents circulated on any social media platform to be purportedly issued by our Office.

We also remind the public that the creation, use, or distribution of falsified documents is a serious offence and may result in legal action.

We remain committed to upholding transparency, integrity, and public trust in all our processes and documentation, and should you receive any suspicious documents claiming to originate from our Ministry, please report it immediately to our Office at email: info@mcil.gov.ws or telephone numbers 20441/20442/20443.
